Lisa receives the freshest flowers from her wholesalers in Elgin and Rockford. From the time of cutting to the florist receiving the product ranges from 2 days to 1 week, allowing maximum freshness for each arrangement.

A fresh mixed flower bouquet is the number one requested for any occasion, with colorful Roses being second. The longest lasting flowers are Daisy's, Carnations, and Mums.

So what do you do with all those floral vases you have collected? Don't throw them away ! Take a trip over to Marengo Greenhouse & Florist and drop them off. Lisa cleans them up and then these vases are used to provide flowers for the local churches.
