

# Marengo Emporium

"If Etsy had a store, this place would be it" daughter Asia says of **Marengo Emporium**. It is vintage eclectic meets modern artisan design type of store. While you can spend hours browsing the unique gifts, home décor and antiques, you will certainly find items for your own home as well as those hard to buy for gifts.

There are so many items for purchase from kaleidoscopes, soy candles, handmade pottery, goat milk soap, dog scarves, shirt off his back aprons, melted down bottles, baby quilts, vintage books, paintings, repurposed furniture, sun catchers, horseshoes, and even an old 45 record made into a working clock.

Anyone who has repurposed items that bring value to resale are welcome to inquire about consignment.

Marengo has a lot of downtown historical buildings and this is one of those building that has been rehabbed but some of the characteristics been left untouched to highlight the original ceilings from the build date of 1875, what once was the building for the very first bank in McHenry County. In the later years, Swonguer Furniture & Undertakers, Marengo Farm Store, Vidiots, Wholly Smokes and State Street Pub occupied the building but perhaps its best known for housing the Marie Ann Dress Shop.
