- We are limited to 20 banners at the present time. Banners are 30x80.
- The Marengo Union Chamber of Commerce holds the copyright for the design of the Hometown Hero Banner and reserves the exclusive right to the content of the banner. Banners that have been purchased by the family of the honoree will be given directly to the purchaser upon removal, unless otherwise designated. Cost of each banner is \$250.00. Donations are accepted. A portion of the proceeds will benefit a scholarship fund specifically for a service member's family.
- All submitted photos must be duplicates. We do realize that some photos will be aged, so please take special consideration to submit one without creases or tears. We cannot guarantee photos will be returned.
- Both sides of the banner will be the same hero. Design of the banner is subject to change.
- The Marengo Union Chamber of Commerce will highlight each of these heroes with a small bio on our website, provided by the family and is subject to editing.
- All banners are printed and stitched locally and we will try our best to confirm all details prior to the final printing. If details cannot be confirmed by the deadline, we reserve the right to choose the next applicant waiting.
- Banners are on a first come/first serve basis. A \$125.00 deposit must be included. If the deposit is not included, the application will be rejected.
